

Quotes from young people about Zeal's impact


- 66 It's helped me get out of my comfort zone in a judge-free space and has also helped me to get over my social anxiety."

Why do you come back to Zeal?


- 66 The staff at Zeal are always welcoming and willing to talk to you and help you out with anything!"


- 66 Gives me an empty headspace where I don't have to think about what's going on outside."

Supporting rangatahi



Quotes from rangatahi about Zeal's support


- 66 Doesn't matter what part of your journey you're at, the staff are always willing to help out with your steps moving forward."




Has Zeal helped you find or connect with other places of support or good advice?

- They feel like friends and family, they all have an amazing vibe and you can tell they are great communicators and listeners.


 Right when I walk in I'm asked about how I am and what's been going on. They sit down and ask with full attention on me which shows how they truly care."


- 66 They're very welcoming and help me with a lot of things that I don't really have anyone else to go to."

50% of young people came with a friend when first connecting with Zeal










Navigating mental health


50% of young people feel sad or down more than once a week, most days or more






62% of young people feel stressed or anxious more than once a week, most days or more

In your words, what needs to change in Aotearoa to address these challenges?

"For things to be discussed more openly and to not feel ashamed of speaking about it."

"Definitely more access to mental health support, it's a really overlooked problem in Aotearoa, and having to go through places that don't quite fully understand can be quite challenging."

"The school system needs to slow down."

"Better help for people who are struggling with crime and discrimination. Not just telling people you will do something but actually doing something about it."

"The law is really strict on youth. They don't do anything to help us change. They just send us to a boy's home or youth justice and expect us to change there. When you get out you've got heaps of emotions which leads to offending again!"

"More emphasis on young people and what's relevant to them as they are the future of Aotearoa."

"Finding jobs for younger people is harder these days since a lot of places employ experienced older people which doesn't give us teens enough learning experience and opportunities. More places should hire younger teens."


"People need to actually do stuff when it comes to climate change we need visible change." "More organisations to help young people that are free and more information about them."




"More funding for mental health, cost of living etc, more government attention and action in climate change, more things for young people to get involved in."

"In regards to vaping there needs to be less vape stores in our community so that young kids don't have access to it."


