



The opportunities and people, it feels like a supportive family"







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
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I feel safe and happy at Zeal. I like the staff and how friendly they are"

It's a welcoming environment that is full of people that are willing to meet other people. Additionally, it is a good place to go when you need positive energy"




Supporting rangatahi

I've always felt welcomed and supported by Zeal. They've always helped me out with personal things, made me laugh and smile and just cool to chill with"







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
I feel more at home here than I do in my own house"

The staff are always eager to talk to me about literally anything, and if I have any issues, there's always someone willing to help me out"





Has Zeal helped you find or connect with other places of support or good advice?




Connection with Zeal staff

Cause these guys never tell you to go away or belittle your issue"








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Always make me feel like I can talk to someone at all times"

They are nice and I can trust them"




Young people's Zeal journey



65% of young people came with a friend when first connecting with Zeal


What first brought you to Zeal?

What have you done at Zeal since?




What could Zeal do better?







Schools need to encourage a balance between school work and living life as a teenager. teachers may suffer from burnout but so do us students"










Ethnicity New Zealand Standard Classification 2021
